Dennis Waits, County Legislator, said he has received numerous calls regarding several damaged properties in the Blue Summit area that need to be removed.

Jay Haden, Assistant County Counselor, said work is being done on this matter.

Terry Young, County Legislator, asked if the televising of the legislative meetings will begin on October 1.

Ken Evans, Public Information Officer, said he would give a report at next week's legislative meeting.

John Trozzolo, producer of Channel 2 for Kansas City, Missouri, said the bid for the portable equipment was awarded last Monday. Therefore, he advised the Legislature that the first televised legislative meeting would probably be either October 9th or 16th as opposed to October 2nd.

Fred Arbanas, County Legislator, asked if the Land Use public hearings held at Fleming Hall would be televised.

Victor E. Callahan advised the Legislature that Sue Duncan, Manager of Administration, indicated that the legislative meeting area in Independence should be completed by January or February 2001. This would provide a permanent meeting area for the Legislature as well as for public hearings.
