WHEREAS, the Jackson County Sheriff's Population Control Office has a need for upgraded electronic monitoring equipment, including GPS monitoring, for use in the County House Arrest program; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends the award of a twelve-month term and supply contract, with one twelve-month option to extend, for the furnishing of this equipment to BI Incorporated of Boulder, CO, under the terms and conditions of OMNIA Partners – City of Mesa, AZ Contract No. 2022118, an existing competitively bid government contract; and,

WHEREAS, the Director recommends award under section 1030.4, Jackson County Code, 1984, to allow the County to take advantage of discounts offered to large entities; and,

WHEREAS the estimated spending under this contract for 2024 is \$341,000.00; now therefore,
