**A RESOLUTION** declaring certain property within various County departments as surplus and unusable personal property and authorizing its disposal.

**RESOLUTION NO. 18292**, November 4, 2013

**INTRODUCED BY** Scott Burnett, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the Circuit Court, Parks + Rec, Corrections, Assessment, and Information Technology Departments have miscellaneous equipment and vehicles that they can no longer use, further described and itemized in the attached Exhibits A through O; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends that said property be declared surplus and unusable and sold at auction, except the Corrections Department's tilt skillet described in Exhibit D that will be recycled for scrap metal; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the property within the various County departments, further described and itemized in Exhibits A through O, be and hereby is declared surplus, and that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to dispose of it as indicated, pursuant to Chapter 11, Jackson County Code, 1984.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a

majority of the Legislature.


