In Room 138 and 139, there are abandoned pipes above a plaster ceiling which is 4' above the finished plaster ceiling. To access this pipe, we will have to demolish some of the lower ceiling to access the upper ceiling. We will then need to remove a portion of the upper ceiling to access the pipe and then remove the asbestos wrapped pipes.

A section of plaster wall will need to be removed to access this pipe and dispose of the asbestos.
