We have completed our review of three proposals for the Commissary Contract, Keefe, Summit and Tiger. I have combined the average of all four panelist scores and provided them below:

Keefe offers the most years of experience with serving facilities with an ADP exceeding 700. Summit offers the highest commission to the County, but they also have much higher prices for commissary items.

We are aware that many of the costs to purchase commissary often become the burden of immediate family members and friends of the detainees. We do not want to increase the burden on families to increase our profit.

Our goal is simply to be able to provide reasonably priced products at a fair and competitive price to the inmate population. We believe that Keefe proposes the best overall service to meet our growing needs and we recommend the commissary contract be awarded to Keefe.
