5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Mike Sanders, County Executive, talked about the Freedom Memorial Wall and referenced Executive Order #15-19, an item on the agenda. The wall will be constructed at 34th and Benton.

He also talked about rising health care cost and said his staff has been working with the Legislative Auditor and the County Legislature on this matter.

Mary Lou Brown, Chief Administrative Officer, said they are in negotiations with the broker, Josh Garry and Blue Cross and Blue Shield. She said the increase is due to usage. She explained employees will have three options: Preferred Provider Organization (PPO), Health Maintenance Organization (HMO) and a high deductible plan with a Health Saving Account (HSA). The Administration will go over the final results of the negotiations with the County Legislature on October 5th, 2015.

Gary Panetheire, Chief Operations Officer, distributed newspaper articles from the New York Times and Kansas City Star indicating insurance rates are increasing nationwide.

Mary Lou Brown indicated that they are down from a forty percent (40%) increase and are hoping to get it down to only a 15% increase from 2015.

Mike Sanders said they will work with employees, are optimistic about the negotiations with Blue Cross and Blue Shield and will present more information to the County Legislature soon.


