5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Katheryn Shields, County Executive, stated that James Stadler, a long time employee of the County's Assessment Department, passed away last Tuesday. James Stadler was a real estate broker prior to working for Jackson County. He also served as President of the Local Chapter of the International Association of Assessing Officers. He was very active in the local chapter of the VFW and was instrumental in the installation of Jackson County's POW/MIA flag. She presented his two sons with a proclamation expressing sincere gratitude and respect for his years of devoted public service to the people of Jackson County.

Katheryn Shields advised members of the Legislature that a new Missouri law recently took effect that increased the fee schedule in the Department of Records. UCC filings will now be centralized within the Secretary of State's office. The fee change took effect July 1, 2001. Information regarding this change will be placed in the mail from the Records Department.

Katheryn Shields said she was pleased to announce that an ATM has been installed in the downtown courthouse on the first floor just inside the Records Department. This has been determined to be the most centralized location in the courthouse. The installation is in response to requests from county employees. Use of the ATM is free to United Missouri Bank cardholders. For those who bank at other institutions, there is a \$1.50 surcharge to use the ATM.

Ms. Shields introduced Jeremiah Finnegan, Jackson County's liaison to the Public Service Commission in Jefferson City. Mr. Finnegan has been handling cases that deal with utility price increases and was present to give an update on the work he has been doing regarding this issue.

County Legislators asked various questions regarding Mr. Finnegan's work in Jefferson City, Missouri.

Mr. Finnegan stated that his fee to undertake a new case on Jackson County's behalf would be between \$7,500 and \$9,500.
