TITLE: A resolution authorizing the County Prosecutor to execute agreements with designated outside agencies, funded through the County's Anti-Crime Sales Tax Fund, for the 2026 fiscal year. The agreements are intended to support anti-crime initiatives, crime prevention, treatment programs and school-based law enforcement activities. With a transfer of 2,212,329.40 from the already budgeted accounts of treatment and LESBI to prevention. The total funding shall not exceed \$12,431,340.40

Renewal of these contracts is contingent upon annual budget appropriations.

SUMMARY:

Combat funding is dedicated to building strong and safe communities across Jackson County by addressing the threats posed by illegal drugs and violent crime. This is achieved through a

comprehensive approach that includes prevention, treatment services, and support for the criminal justice system.

This resolution authorizes the County Prosecutor to execute agreements with selected outside agencies, funded by the County's Anti-Crime Sales Tax Fund, for fiscal year 2026. These agencies are engaged in anti-crime and anti-violence prevention efforts, treatment programs, and school-based law enforcement initiatives. With a transfer of 1,551,391.00 from treatment and 660,939.00 from LESBI of the already budgeted accounts to the prevention account. Total funding for these agreements shall not exceed \$12,431,340.40. The funding categories are as follows:
