BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the Cooperative Agreements for the Outside Agency referred to above shall be extended through March 31, 2026, as recommended by the County Executive and the County Legislature and, at no cost to the County; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive and all other County officials be and hereby are authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to give effect to the intent of this Resolution.
