WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends the award of twenty-four month term and supply contracts with one twelve-month option to extend to Kenton Brothers, Inc., of Kansas City, MO, and Greg's Lock & Key Service of Independence, MO, as the lowest and best bidders; and,

WHEREAS, a split award is requested to give the County flexibility and convenience to obtain needed items and services in either Independence or Kansas City locations; and,

WHEREAS, this award is made on an as-needed basis and does not obligate Jackson County to pay any specific amount, with the availability of funds for specific purchases being subject to annual appropriation of \$102,000.00 annually; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that award be made as recommended by the Director of Finance and Purchasing, and that the Director be and hereby is authorized to execute for the County any documents necessary for the accomplishment of the award; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Finance is authorized to make all payments to the extent that sufficient appropriations to the using spending agencies are available in the then current Jackson County budget.
