The Jackson County Compliance Review Office has found Pyramid Contractors Contractor Utilization Plan to be in compliance.</p> <p>Funding for this project is included in the current fiscal year budget. The Parks+Rec Department respectfully requests the Legislature accept the bid from Pyramid Contractors, Inc. and award a contract on Bid No. PW-11-2016 in the amount of \$774,523.00 with an additional amount of 5% of the contract value (\$38,726.15) authorized for a Force Account Contingency Fund to be utilized for additional project expenditures as may be needed as authorized by the Director of the Parks+Rec Department. The Department further requests authorization for the County Executive to execute the Contract for this bid.</p> <p>This project is the first phase in a collaborative effort between Jackson County and the City of Kansas City, Missouri to extend the Little Blue Trace trail. A bid opening for Bid No. PW-11-2016, for the Little Blue Trace Trail Extension Phase One, was held on November 15, 2016. A total of nine bids were received. Pyramid Contractors, Inc. of Olathe, KS submitted the lowest and best bid in the amount of \$774,523.00. The Jackson County Compliance Review Office has found Pyramid Contractors Contractor Utilization Plan to be in compliance.

Funding for this project is included in the current fiscal year budget. The Parks + Rec Department respectfully requests the Legislature accept the bid from Pyramid Contractors, Inc. and award a contract on Bid No. PW-11-2016 in the amount of \$774,523.00 with an additional amount of 5% of the contract value (\$38,726.15) authorized for a Force Account Contingency Fund to be utilized for additional project expenditures as may be needed as authorized by the Director of the Parks+Rec Department. The Department further requests authorization for the County Executive to execute the Contract for this bid.

The base bid scope of work for this project includes approximately one half-mile of paved concrete trail (10' wide x 6" thick), two pedestrian bridges, and a forty car parking area. Additional scopes for work for add-alternates, which may be selected at the discretion of the County, include additional clearing, stormwater infrastructure, base stabilization and paving for additional sections of trail.

This project is the first phase in a collaborative effort between Jackson County and the City of Kansas City, Missouri to extend the Little Blue Trace trail. Resolution 17650 approved by the Jackson County Legislature on September 9, 2011 authorized a Cooperative Agreement for the extension of the trail from Lee's Summit Road to Longview Lake. Kansas City has contributed matching funds for this first phase of the project in the amount of \$675,000.

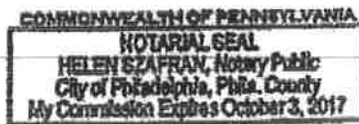

A bidder may withdraw his Proposal any time prior to expiration of the period during which Proposals may be submitted by a written request signed in the same manner and by the same person who signed the Proposal.

B-8 ACCEPTANCE AND REJECTION OF BIDS: The Owner reserves the right to accept the bid which, in its judgement, is the lowest and best bid; to reject any or all bids; and to waive irregularities or informalities in any bid. Bids received after the specified time of closing will be returned unopened.

B-9 SIGNATURE OF BIDDERS: Each bidder shall sign his Proposal using his usual signature and giving his full business address. Bids by partnerships shall be signed with the partnership name followed by the signature and designation of one of the partners or other authorized representative. Bids by corporations shall be signed with the name of the corporation followed by the signature and designation of the president, secretary, or other person authorized to bind the corporation. The names of all persons signing should also be typed or printed below the signature. A bid by a person who affixed to his signature the word "president", "secretary", "agent", or other designation without disclosing his principal, may be held to be the bid of the individual signing. When requested by the Owner, satisfactory evidence of the authority of the person signing shall be furnished.

B-10 INTERPRETATION OF CONTRACT DOCUMENTS: If any person who contemplated submitting a bid is in doubt as to the true meaning of any part of the Plans, Specifications, or other proposed Contract documents, he may submit to the engineer a written request for an interpretation thereof. The person submitting the request shall be responsible for its prompt delivery. Interpretation of the proposed Contract documents will be made only by addendum. A copy of each addendum will be mailed or delivered to each person obtaining a set of Contract documents from the Director of Public Works. The Owner will not be responsible for any other explanations or interpretations of the proposed Contract documents.

B-11 LOCAL CONDITIONS AFFECTING WORK: Each bidder shall visit the site of the work and shall completely inform himself relative to construction hazards and procedure, labor, and all other conditions and factors, local and otherwise, which would affect prosecution and completion of the work and its cost. Such considerations shall include the arrangement and condition of existing structures and storage facilities, the procedure necessary for maintenance of uninterrupted operation of existing facilities for transportation, handling, and storage of materials and equipment. All such factors shall be properly investigated and considered in the preparation of the bidder's proposal. There will be no subsequent financial adjustment for lack of such prior information.

B-12 INSURANCE: Throughout the life of the contract, the contractor will be required to carry the types and amounts of insurance named in the General Conditions.

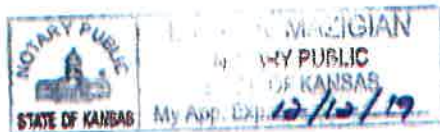
