

**FIRST ADDENDUM TO  
COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT**

THIS FIRST ADDENDUM made this 26<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2012, by and between JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI, hereinafter called "County" and LEE'S SUMMIT UNDERWATER RESCUE AND RECOVERY, P.O. Box 6575, Lee's Summit, MO 64064, a not-for-profit organization, hereinafter called "Underwater Recovery."

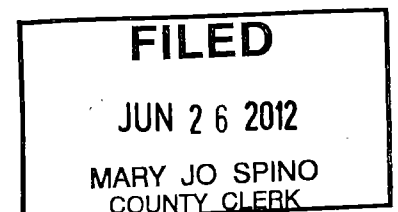
WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Underwater Recovery and County entered into a Cooperative Agreement dated April 18, 2012, whereunder Underwater Recovery agreed to provide water rescue services within Jackson County, as authorized by Resolution 17769, dated January 9, 2012, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$12,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, Underwater Recovery and County now desire to enter into this Addendum to the Cooperative Agreement whereunder the County shall increase the funding allocation for these services for 2012 at an additional cost to the County not to exceed \$10,670.00; and,

WHEREAS, the execution of this addendum is authorized by Resolution 17921, dated June 11, 2012;


NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the terms and provisions herein contained, County and Underwater Recovery respectively agree with each other as follows:



1. Except as expressly provided herein, all provisions of the Cooperative Agreement between Underwater Recovery and County, dated April 18, 2012, shall remain in full force and effect.
2. This First Addendum to the Cooperative Agreement, together with the Cooperative Agreement, dated April 18, 2012, shall be effective until December 31, 2012.
3. The Cooperative Agreement of April 18, 2012, is amended by the addition of Exhibit B attached hereto, to be included with the Exhibit A attached to the Cooperative Agreement.
4. The maximum sum to be paid by County to Underwater Recovery shall be increased by the amount of \$10,670.00, for a maximum total of \$22,670.00. Because Underwater Recovery has received a payment in the amount of \$3,000.00 under the Cooperative Agreement dated April 18, 2012, Underwater Recovery shall receive a payment of one-quarter of the increase, or \$2,667.50, payable upon execution of this addendum. The remaining quarterly payments in the amount of \$5,667.50 shall be made upon the County's receipt of the reports as set forth in paragraph 3 of the Cooperative Agreement.
5. This First Addendum to the Cooperative Agreement, together with the Cooperative Agreement dated April 18, 2012, incorporates the entire understanding and agreement of the parties.




