## MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR HIGHWAY CROSSING IMPROVEMENTS

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into by the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (hereinafter, "Commission"), the Union Pacific Railroad Company (hereinafter, "Railroad"), and the County of Jackson (hereinafter, "County"), pursuant to the terms of a Master Signal Agreement between the Railroad and Commission executed by the Railroad on August 20, 1980, and by the Commission on September 11, 1980, (hereinafter, "Master Agreement").

### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the installation of grade crossing warning devices appears to be warranted at an existing grade crossing west of Levasy in Jackson County where Schuster Road intersects Railroad tracks (a crossing designated as DOT# 442 299S); and

WHEREAS, the parties agree that this installation shall be in substantial compliance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), and shall enhance safety to both highway and railroad traffic at said grade crossing.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of these premises and of the mutual covenants herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

- PURPOSE: The purpose of this Agreement is to provide for funding, installation, and maintenance of additional warning devices at this highway/rail crossing (herein after, "Project").
- SCOPE OF WORK: The scope of work includes the installation of flashing (2)light (LED) signals and gates with redundant constant warning time circuitry, the installation of two audible bells, and the installation of new signal bungalow highway/rail crossing located on Schuster Road (DOT# 442 299S) by the Railroad at Commission's and Railroad expense.
- The Commission will reimburse the Railroad for eighty percent (80%) of the Railroad's cost to install the warning devices at Schusier Road

The Railroad will assume responsibility for the remaining twenty percent (20%) cost to install the warning devices at Schuster Road.

- (4) <u>COST OF PROJECT</u>: The cost of the project will be the total monies expended by the Railroad to complete the installation of the active warning devices in accordance with the plan and cost estimate developed by the Railroad for this specific project and attached to this Agreement.
- (5) <u>PRELIMINARY WORK:</u> The Railroad will prepare and submit to the Commission a plan and cost estimate for the work as described during the diagnostic field review conducted February 18, 2010, and in accordance with the provisions of the Master Agreement.
- (6) <u>CHANGE ORDERS:</u> If any change is made in the original plan and extent of the work, reimbursement to the Railroad shall be limited to costs covered by a change order having approval of the Commission prior to the performance of the work.
- (7) <u>INSTALLATION:</u> Upon receipt of notification from the Commission, the Railroad shall furnish all labor and material and complete the installation of active warning devices in accordance with the Master Agreement and in accordance with the plan and estimate attached hereto, and the rules and regulations contained in the Federal-Aid Program Guide.
- (8) FORCE ACCOUNT AND NON-FORCE ACCOUNT WORK: The Railroad will furnish all of the material and do all of the work with its own forces, or the work may be done by a contractor paid under a contract let by the Railroad in compliance with the applicable provisions of 23 C.F.R. Chapter 1, Subchapter B, Part 140, Subpart 1. Said Title 23 Code of Federal Regulations (23 C.F.R.) is by reference made a part of this agreement to the extent of the applicable work.
- (9) MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION: The Railroad shall operate and maintain the active warning devices at the Railroad's expense as long as it operates trains through the crossing; or until the Commission orders that active warning devices are no longer necessary at the crossing; or until the crossing is abandoned, closed, or for any reason the operation and maintenance of the active warning devices become unnecessary.
- (10) <u>RELOCATION OF SIGNALS:</u> In the event the warning devices become unnecessary for any of the above reasons, the Railroad shall remove and install the devices at another crossing mutually acceptable to the Commission and the Railroad, and subject to the approval of the Commission.
  - (11) PAYMENT PROVISIONS: Upon receipt of the Railroad's statement in

relation to the work performed, the Commission will reimburse the Railroad for one hundred percent (100%) of the Commission's obligation which is eighty percent (80%) of the total Project cost at Schuster Road highway/rail crossing. If audit reveals that the Railroad has been overpaid, the Railroad will immediately refund to the Commission such overpayment. If the audit reveals that the Railroad has been underpaid, the Commission will reimburse the Railroad for such underpayment.

- (12) <u>COUNTY OBLIGATION:</u> The County hereby agrees to cooperate with the handling of traffic during construction of the Project.
- (13) <u>AMENDMENTS:</u> Any change in this Agreement, whether by modification or supplementation, must be accomplished by a formal contract amendment signed and approved by the duly authorized representation of the parties hereto.
- (14) <u>COMMISSION REPRESENTATIVE</u>: The Commission's director is designated as the Commission's representative for the purpose of administering the provisions of this Agreement.
- (15) <u>ASSIGNMENT:</u> The Railroad shall not assign, transfer, or delegate and interest in this Agreement without prior written consent of the Commission.
- (16) <u>LAW OF MISSOURI TO GOVERN:</u> This Agreement shall be construed according to the laws of the State of Missouri. The Railroad and the City shall comply with all local, state, and federal laws and regulations relating to the performance of this Agreement.
- (17) <u>VENUE</u>: It is agreed by the parties hereto that any actions at law, suit in equity, or other judicial proceeding to enforce or construe this Agreement, or regarding its alleged breach, shall be instituted only in the Circuit Court of Cole County, Missouri.
- (18) <u>CANCELLATION</u>: The Commission may cancel this Agreement at any time for a material breach of contractual obligations by providing the Railroad with written notice of cancellation. Should the Commission exercise its right to cancel the Agreement for such reasons, cancellation will become effective upon the date specified in the notice of cancellation sent to the Railroad.
- (19) <u>AUDIT OF RECORDS</u>: The Railroad shall maintain all records relating to this Agreement, including but not limited to invoices and payrolls. These records must be available at all reasonable times at no charge to the Commission and/or its designees or representative during the period of this Agreement and any extension thereof, and for three (3) years from the date of final payment made under this Agreement.



#### **SECTION 5. APPROVAL OF PROJECT**

A. THE PROPOSED PROJECT IS APPROVED AND AUTHORIZED AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 4 OF THIS ORDER, FOR THE FOLLOWING REASON(S):

1. The proposed project will not adversely affect public necessity, and will promote public safety, if it is completed and maintained in conformity with the terms of this Administrative Order.

## **SECTION 6. ADDITIONAL FINDINGS AND ORDERS**

- A. MHTC FINDS AND ORDERS THAT EACH RESPONSIBLE PARTY IDENTIFIED IN SECTION 4 SHALL:
  - 1. Proceed with the construction and installation of the project in conformity with Section 4 of this Administrative Order. Each responsible party shall notify the MoDOT district area engineer where the project is located, not less than five (5) days before beginning field work.
  - 2. Complete all required project work described in Section 4 of this order, not later than the Ordered Due Date stated above in Section 4 of this Administrative Order.
  - 3. Submit written notice of completion of all assigned project work items to MoDOT's Railroad Administrator, not later than the ordered due date for completion of such work.
  - 4. Maintain each device or other safety improvement as provided in Section 4 of this order.
  - 5. Submit project final bills for all work reimbursable by MHTC as provided in Section 4 of this order, not later than eight (8) months after submission of notice of completion, or funds will no longer be available.

#### SECTION 7. ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING; JUDICIAL REVIEW

Any interested party may file an application for review of this Administrative Order with the Missouri Administrative Hearing Commission (AHC). Upon the filing of such an application, AHC acquires exclusive jurisdiction to review, determine, prescribe or deny the project, as provided by law. Then AHC may conduct hearings, make findings of fact and conclusions of law, and issue orders determining this project.
