REQUEST SUMMARY	A resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute agreements with certain outside agencies funded by the County's Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund for the 2017 fiscal year, which are engaged in anti-violence activities and purposes, at an aggregate cost to the county not to exceed \$315,000.00. Exhibit A: indicates the outside agencies and funding levels as recommended. Background: The Anti-Drug Tax Fund authorizes the County to execute agreements and contracted service for the purpose of providing substance abuse treatment, prevention, grant match and other anti-drug and anti-violence initiatives in the community. The original AVSI projects were based upon evaluation of proposals that were submitted in response by the community providers to Request for Proposal (#59-13) for a special COMBAT Anti-Violence Special Initiative.			
A change in 2009 in the authorizing language for COMBAT allowed the addition of effective anti-dru strategies. The recommendations to fund these proposed programs will continue COMBAT's efforts to Jackson County in providing strategies to reduce the violence within our community.				
	Seven projects are requested to be funded by the Jackson County Legislature in 2017. Based on evaluation of the 2016 projects, these seven agencies are being recommended for the 2017 funding. This action was approved by the Drug Commission on February 21, 2017.
