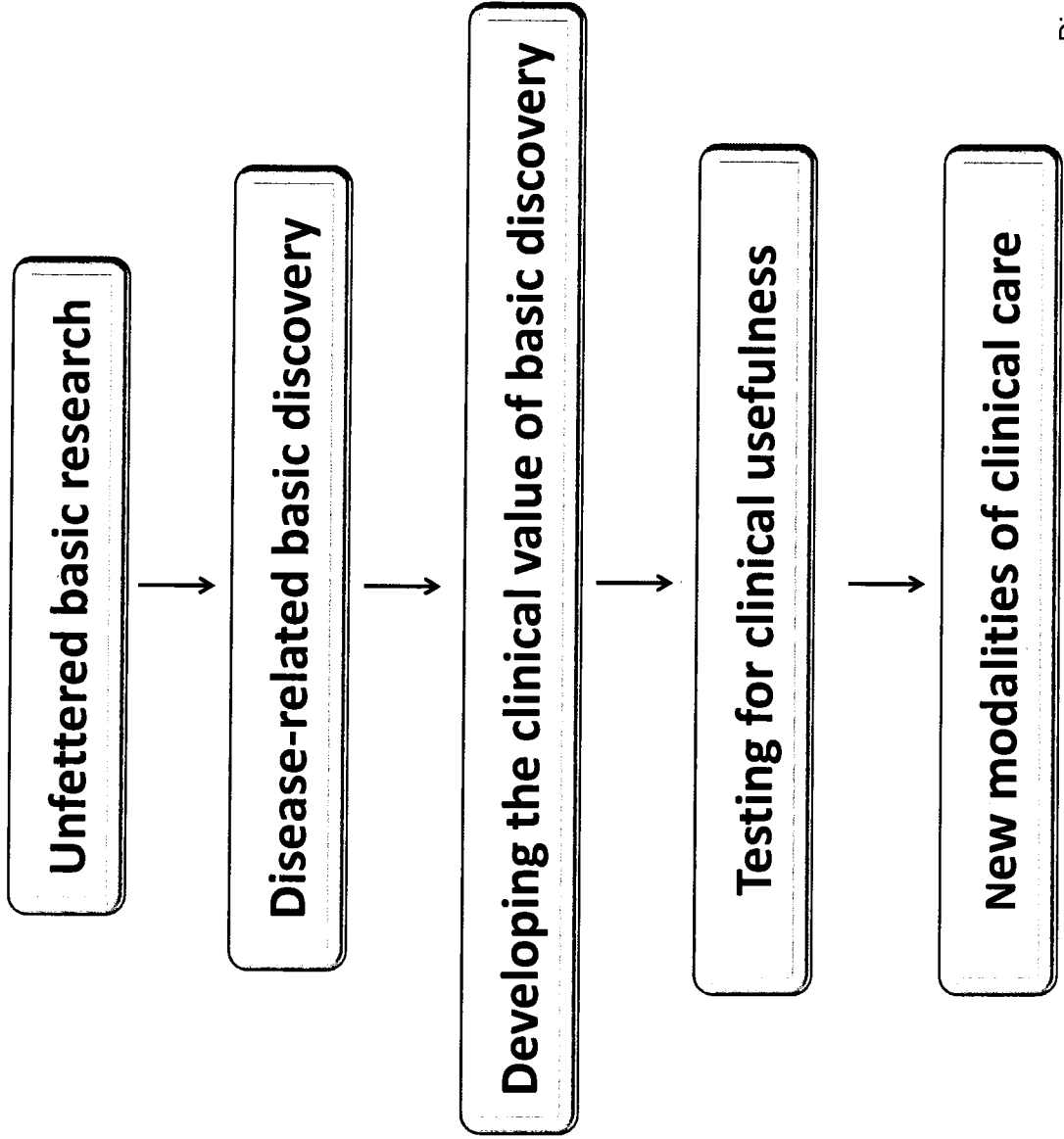

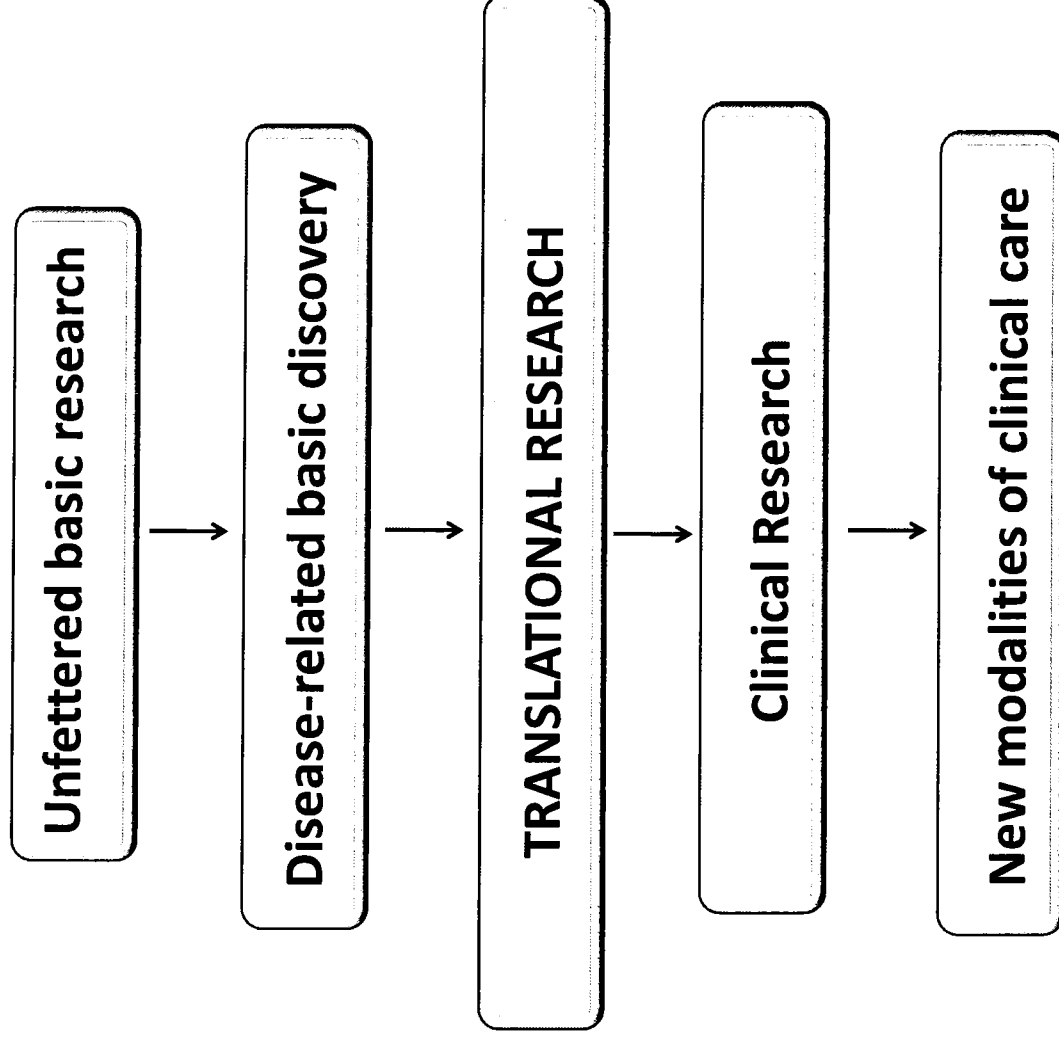

Summary of modifications to MOU:

-Date change to August 26, 2013

-Added Jackson County as a signatory and party to the document

-Added the underlined language below:

WHEREAS, the Research organizations have engaged in discussions as to the process and collaborative activities necessary to achieve results of drug and device discovery leading to cures for the population of our region and the nation, including expanding the research currently being performed on illnesses that affect the minority community in Jackson County, and will result in the commercialization of new products and the start-up of new companies, as evidenced by the Overview; and

Summary of modifications to Overview Document:

Section 2. Adding a member of the Jackson County Legislature as a voting member of the Board of Directors

Section 2.A. Modifying the date that the MOU with the partners and county executive must be signed to August 26 (from August 1).

Section 2.D. Deleted the "example" organizations from the Community Advisory Board.

Section 5. Deleting the "sample" ballot language (since the final ballot language will be in the ordinance).

Modifications to Ordinance:

Updated date of MOU and Overview

Added same expansion of work on diseases as in MOU

Added reimbursement of election costs from tax proceeds

August 26, 2013

Added "human" diseases distinction to ballot language

Added open meeting and Fair Share language

Added a clause providing that job openings will be published throughout the county

Added a provision that the use of the 20% "carried interest" will subject to the approval of the Legislature

Added a provision that appointments to all committees, with the exception of the Scientific Advisory Board and the Board of Directors shall be county residents.
