INTRODUCED BY James D. Tindall, County Legislator

WHEREAS, section 141.750.2, RSMo 2000, authorizes the Trustees of the Land Trust of Jackson County to convey title in fee simple for consideration less than two-thirds of the appraised value of a property, only after the consent of at least two of the Trustees' appointing authorities; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Kansas City, Missouri, by its Resolution 110072, approved February 10, 2011, has delegated the authority to its Director of Neighborhood and Community Services Department to approve the transfer of blighted properties held by Land Trust of Jackson County to neighborhood-based non-profit corporations for rehabilitation; and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution 17509, dated February 14, 2011, the Legislature did express its support for these efforts of the City Council and staff of the City of Kansas City to reduce blight in the city's urban core; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Kansas City, Missouri Director Neighborhood and Community

Services Department has recommended that the property located at 10521 Blue Ridge Blvd., Kansas City, MO, legally described as Craigview Acres South 1/2 of Lot 3, parcel number 49-740-06-14-00-0-000, be conveyed to Bridge Leadership Academy, Inc., of Kansas City (Jackson County), MO, a Missouri non-profit corporation, to support the rehabilitation of the property that was otherwise scheduled for demolition, in an effort to curb blight within the urban core; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the Land Trust Trustees be authorized to convey the property located at 10521 Blue Ridge Blvd., Kansas City, MO, for an amount of less than two-thirds market value, to the Bridge Leadership Academy, Inc., a Missouri non-profit corporation, for the purpose of better maintaining this property and revitalizing the area in which it is located; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, encourages the Land Trust Trustees to include and enforce reversionary clauses in the conveyances regarding redevelopment of the properties within a prescribed time frame; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Land Trust Trustees are hereby authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to convey the above-described property for less than two-thirds market value.

The mission of The Bridge Leadership Academy (Bridge) is to inspire and develop forward-thinking progressive young leaders through character-based development, educational, personal and professional discovery and a commitment to serve the community.

### Organizational History and Background

The Bridge Leadership Academy is a community-led youth leadership empowerment program that works in collaboration with Kansas City metropolitan school districts, community-based organizations and corporations to provide educational and leadership development programs for predominately at-risk inner city youth who are primarily low-income and minority of both genders, ages 12 to 16 years old. Both as an agency and through our individual administrators, Bridge has extensive experience providing youth programs. While being a relatively new organization, the Bridge leadership team has over 30 years of experience in education and student development.

Bridge Leadership Academy was founded by Wakisha Briggs. Ms. Briggs currently serves as the President of the Board of Directors. Ms. Briggs has a Master of Arts in Adult Education and is the Director of Continuing Education for Park University. She is also the Women's Head Basketball Coach at Penn Valley Community College. variety of proven approaches for improving educational and skill competencies to increase each student's grade
level in reading, math, science and other basic skills. Further, our aim is to provide preparation for postsecondary educational opportunities to students from the Hickman School District. The Bridge program
integrates emerging Internet technology with traditional service delivery practices. Services will include, but are
not limited to: assessment, career and personal coaching, educational workshops, hands-on computer literacy
training, guidance on secondary school re-entry or entry into GED programs, and assistance in completing
institutional admissions and financial aid applications. Instruction is provided through face-to-face interaction,
small group and collaborative learning platforms. Additionally, the program will provide character-based
development through peer mentoring, educational workshops, community service projects, and social activities.
We provide youth with the skills necessary not only to stay in school, but to excel in all areas of their lives.

### **Problem Statement and Population Served**

In Kansas City metropolitan area schools, more than 40 percent of students fail to graduate from high school on time and the dropout rates are disproportionately higher for minority and low-income students. "The number one predictor of a young person's future success is whether they graduate from high school," said Alma Powell, Chair of America's Promise. "Research shows that young people who drop out are more likely to be incarcerated, rely on public programs and social services and go without health insurance." It is estimated that increasing graduation rates by 10 percentage points would prevent 25 murders and 1,700 aggravated assaults in Kansas City alone. Bridge leadership believes there are no simplistic answers because the obstacles inner-city, at risk youth must overcome are both many and formidable. We believe there must be a concentrated effort applied to each young person if they are to succeed. The Bridge Leadership program focuses on fundamental keys to each student's success — academics, social skills development, character education and community service.

### **Programming Solutions**

Our goal is to introduce life skills competencies that allow low-income, at risk students to apply critical thinking skills and mature judgment, tolerate ambiguity, build intellectual curiosity, work collaboratively to achieve personal and team goals, communicate effectively and successfully transition into post-secondary educational environments. Through leadership, empowerment, commitment, and an integrated blended learning approach, the Bridge Leadership Academy fosters future leaders who will make meaningful contributions to society.

### Determining Success: Benefits to the Neighborhood and General Public

It is anticipated Bridge Leadership program youth will graduate from high school and attend a post-secondary institution. Additionally, they will have higher class attendance, increased academic and social skills and a greater sense of self-worth. We anticipate Bridge youth will be more actively involved in their communities and will become life-long learners and volunteers. Additionally, Bridge student participants will be less likely to become involved in risky behaviors. They will be less likely to use marijuana or other drugs, drink alcohol, smoke cigarettes and engage in premature sexual activity.

We will provide quantitative information critical to the evaluation process, including: the number of youth served by age, race, sex, and academic standing, the number of youth that complete the Bridge program, graduate from high school and attend a post-secondary institution. We will also provide information on the demonstrated impact of the project on the youth's quality of life.

### Sustainability

Bridge will sustain and expand its programs by pursuing supporters that share the vision, and have the means and desire to aid these youth who currently have few or no resources of their own. Both separately and through collaboration with our partner agencies, Bridge will aggressively pursue all appropriate sources of funding, including federal grants, private foundations, and corporate contributions.


