A RESOLUTION nominating candidate for appointment to the Jackson County Sports Complex Authority, for a term to expire July 15, 2029.

RESOLUTION NO. 21868, February 18, 2025

INTRODUCED BY DaRon McGee, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the term of Bradley Madison Scott as a member of the Jackson County Sports Complex Authority expired on July 15, 2024, and this has resulted in a vacancy on the authority; and,

WHEREAS, Carson Ross was appointed to fill this vacancy in an interim capacity by Governor Parson and such appointment was withdrawn on January 14, 2025; and,

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Legislature intends to nominate Carson Ross along with two additional candidates for the vacant position on the Jackson County Sports Complex Authority; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to §64.930, RSMo 2016, and case law construing said section, in the event of a vacancy, a panel of three nominees shall be submitted by majority vote of the County Legislature to the governor for appointment; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following nominees shall be submitted to the governor for his consideration for final appointment to fill the vacancy on the Jackson County Sports Complex Authority occasioned by the expiration of the term of Bradley Madison Scott, for a new term to expire July 15, 2029;

- B. Matthew Haase
- C. Joe Hudson

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Legislature be and hereby is directed to submit this panel to the governor by providing him a true and correct copy hereof.
