

AGREEMENT
(2015 COMBAT Drug Commission DARE)

AN AGREEMENT by and between Jackson County, Missouri, hereinafter referred to as "County", and, **KANSAS CITY BOARD OF POLICE COMMISSIONERS, 1125 LOCUST, KANSAS CITY, MO 64106**, hereinafter referred to as "the Board" made and entered into this 22nd day of May, 2015.

WHEREAS, the Board has requested funding from County's Anti-Drug Sales Tax Funds to assist the Board in defraying certain costs of its Drug Abuse Resistance Education (DARE) or similar anti-drug program; and,

WHEREAS, the County's COMBAT Drug Commission recommended and the County Legislature approved the Board's request as an appropriate expenditure of Anti-Drug Sales Tax Funds; and,

WHEREAS, this Agreement provides a suitable mechanism by which the designated County funds shall be disbursed to the Board;

NOW THEREFORE it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

1. The County agrees to pay to the Board a total amount not to exceed **\$227,000.00**. Upon execution of this contract, an advance payment equal to one-half of the contract amount, totaling **\$113,500.00** will be submitted to the Board. Prior to September 30, 2015, and upon receipt and approval of the previous DARE Semester Report, the final payment equal shall be made. This award is contingent upon collection of sales taxes as budgeted at the time of the contract award. If COMBAT funds are reduced, contractor will be informed of necessary contract revisions, as provided for in this Agreement.
2. The County agrees and acknowledges that the Board shall use the proceeds of this Agreement, together with Board funds and any federal or state grant funds which may have been awarded, to cover certain expenses of its DARE or similar anti-drug program, all as is more fully set out in the funding request and other documents attached hereto as Exhibits A.
3. The Board agrees that all proceeds of this Agreement shall be subject to audit by the County's Legislative Auditor or such other auditor as the County may designate. Additionally, the Board agrees to contract for the performance of a comprehensive audit in conformance with the Single Audit Act of 1984, and to forward two copies of the audit report to the COMBAT Drug Commission, one of which will be forwarded to the County's Department of Finance and Purchasing.
4. The Board shall provide an annual program report at the end of each calendar year summarizing all activities of its DARE or similar anti-drug program to the

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to the County within ten (10) days of the termination of this Agreement.

WORK AUTHORIZATION AFFIDAVIT

As a condition for any service provided to the County, a business entity shall, by sworn affidavit and provision of documentation, affirm its enrollment and participation in a federal work authorization program with respect to the employees working in connection with the contracted services.

Business entity, as defined in section 285.525, RSMo pertaining to section 285.530, RSMo, is any person or group of persons performing or engaging in any activity, enterprise, profession, or occupation for gain, benefit, advantage, or livelihood. The term "business entity" shall include but not be limited to self-employed individuals, partnerships, corporations, contractors, and subcontractors. The term "business entity" shall include any business entity that possesses a business permit, license, or tax certificate issued by the state, any business entity that is exempt by law from obtaining such a business permit, and any business entity that is operating unlawfully without such a business permit.

Every such business entity shall complete the following affidavit affirming that it does not knowingly employ any person who is an unauthorized alien in connection with the contracted services. The completed affidavit must be returned as a part of the contract documentation.

This affidavit affirms that **Kansas City Board of Police Commissioners**, (Organization name) is enrolled in, and is currently participating in, E-verify or any other equivalent electronic verification of work authorization operated by the United States Department of Homeland Security under the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986 (IRCA); and, **Kansas City Board of Police Commissioners**, does not knowingly employ any person who is an unauthorized alien in conjunction with the contracted services.

In Affirmation thereof, the facts stated above are true and correct. (The undersigned understands that false statements made in this filing are subject to the penalties provided under section 575.040, RSMo.)
