5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Katheryn Shields, County Executive, said a committee has been set up to choose the employee of the month for the Employee Recognition Awards. The committee members are Katheryn Shields, County Executive, Dennis Waits, County Legislator, Jane McQueeny, County Counselor, Pattie Castro, Assessment Department, Rick Perry, Personnel, and Nancy Riley, Public Works Department. She thanked the County Legislature for their support in moving forward with this program for the employees of Jackson County.

She said the janitorial bids have been received and analysis has been done. There is an add-on Resolution on the agenda and it will be discussed in committee next week.
