REQUEST SUMMARY	This resolution authorizes the County Executive, on behalf of the Jackson County Prosecutor, to enter into the second addendum to the agreement with Twelfth Street Heritage Development Corporation for the Employment Barriers Program, which was previously bid on RFP 17-16 and 12 <sup>th</sup> Street was authorized for an agreement of \$76,000 for 2017. This employment contract with 12 <sup>th</sup> Street Heritage provides direct employment services for ex-felons, court involved or "at-risk" adults along with personal development and access to resources (i.e. counseling, heath care, skill building, etc.). Based on the success of the program, the Prosecutor's Office is looking to refer additional clients for services and continuation of the program through the term of the agreement (December 31, 2017), at an additional cost to the County not to exceed \$34,200.00.
