<p>REQUEST SUMMARY</p>	<p>A bid opening for Bid # PW-06-2020 for construction of Little Blue Trace Trail Improvements at M-78 Highway was held July 24, 2020 at the Public Works Department. A total of 8 bids were received. Radmacher Brothers Excavating Company Inc. submitted the apparent low bid in the amount of \$422,411.82. All bids were over the projected amount, but the project remains a high priority for the safety of trail users. Therefore, Parks + Rec recommends the transfer of funds so that the project may proceed.</p> <p>After the bid opening Parks + Rec requested, and received, a 25% increase in our previous grant amount for the project from the Missouri Department of Natural Resources. Amendment #1 to the grant agreement, increasing our grant total, is recommended for action by separate Ordinance. Upon approval of that Ordinance, the remaining balance in Grant Fund 010-1608-58060 will be \$380,170.60. Parks + Rec will then use that remaining balance and combine it with \$42,241.22 from 003-1608-58060 Park Fund – Other Improvements to fund the bid amount of \$422,411.82</p> <p>We are therefore requesting \$42,241.22 from 003-1608-8060 Park Fund – Other Improvements be allocated to supplement our grant funding to cover the extra amount needed to award the bid. Mr. Schulte,

Bid No. PW-06-2020 for construction of Little Blue Trace Trail Improvements at M-78 Highway Was opened on July 21, 2020. A total of 8 bids were received. All bids were over our available project budget. After the bid opening, the Parks + Rec department requested and received from MoDNR a 25% increase in our previous grant amount for the project. Amendment #1 increasing our grant total is being acted upon in a separate Ordinance.

The Parks Department is also requesting \$42,256.33 from 003-1608-8060 Park Fund – Other Improvements be appropriated to supplement our grant funding to cover the extra amount needed to award the bid.

The Parks department understands that this project is a high priority to the safety of trail users and recommends the transfer of funds so that the project may proceed.

We recommend award of the bid to the apparent low bidder, Radmacher Brothers Excavation Inc in the amount of \$422,411.82. Radmacher is in compliance with the Contractor Utilization Plan goals set by the Compliance Review office.


