Dennis Waits said he thought the procedure applied when the County Legislature appoints committees. He reminded legislators that the light rail system will be important to eastern Jackson County so we need representation on the planning committees. He noted that Jackson County has needs also like a metropolitan regional jail and a new courthouse in eastern Jackson County, so we will be competing against our own needs. He also has a concern with regards to cost overruns and who will pay. He suggested considering all these issues when deliberating.
