AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$16,638.00 from the unappropriated fund balance of the 2011 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund in acceptance of funds from the Kansas City Board of Police Commissioners and authorizing the County Executive to execute addenda to the Cooperative Agreements with certain municipalities within Jackson County for the purpose of providing additional funds for their 2011 Drug Abuse Resistance Education (DARE) programs, at a total cost to the County not to exceed \$16,638.00.
