5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Katheryn Shields, County Executive, said there is an Intergovernmental Cooperation between the City of Kansas City and Jackson County and there is an agreement before the Legislature for the County to collect real property taxes for the City. Therefore, taxpayers in Kansas City, Jackson County will only receive one bill for real estate this year.

Katheryn Shields reported that the County will schedule one to two lunches per month with businesses outside of Kansas City so they can meet the County Executive and discuss economic development in eastern Jackson County.

Katheryn Shields announced that Jackson County has a day camp at Lake Jacomo which is open eight to ten weeks per year. This year the County provided transportation for six to ten children from the Kansas City Courthouse. Jackson County employees were able to use this benefit for an additional cost of \$10.00 per week. Next year the Administration will take a survey from employees in Independence and if there is enough interest will provide the same benefit to the employees of eastern Jackson County.

Carl Bussey, County Legislator, presented a twenty year service pin to Barbara Dater, an employee in the Collections Department.
