

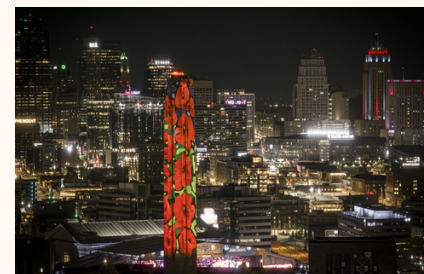

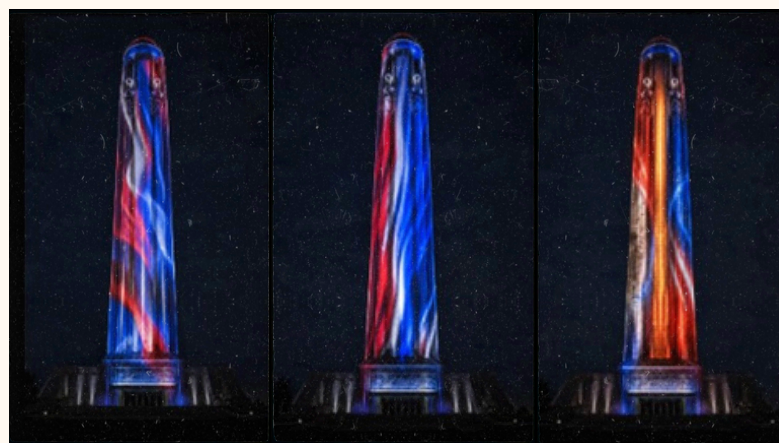

LIBERTY'S BEACON will illuminate the iconic Liberty Memorial Tower from September 21 through November 11, 2026, creating a sustained artistic celebration visible across Kansas City and beyond. This isn't simply lighting—it's a beacon of unity that honors veterans, champions democracy, and tells the story of American resilience through cutting-edge artistic expression.

The installation will draw visitors from across the nation during these historic anniversaries, creating a national platform for meaningful commemoration and forward-looking dialogue about core American ideals.



More than one hundred years ago, 83,000 Kansas City families raised the equivalent of \$45 million in ten days to build the National WWI Museum and Memorial.



COMMISSIONED ARTISTS & RENDERINGS

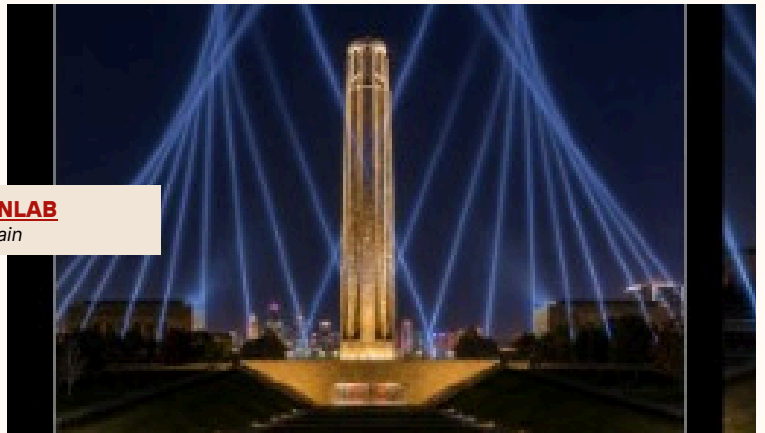
