COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT
(Greater Kansas City Sports Commission and Foundation)
(Buck O'Neil Negro Leagues Baseball Classic)

THIS COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT, by and between **JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI**, hereinafter referred to as "the County," and the **Kansas City Sports Commission and Foundation**, 1308 Pennsylvania, Kansas City, Missouri 64105, hereinafter referred to as "Sports Commission," is made and entered into this 13 day of July, 2010.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County and Sports Commission desire to enter into an Agreement, whereby the County will co-sponsor the Buck O'Neil Negro Leagues Baseball Classic baseball tournament, at a cost to the County of \$3,744.00; and,

WHEREAS, the tournament educates participants on the history of the Negro Leagues, provides a competitive tournament experience and a platform to promote baseball to the urban and inner-city youth of Jackson County; and,

WHEREAS, the sponsorship of this program is in the best interests of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of Jackson County;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the terms and provisions herein contained, the County and Sports Commission respectively promise, covenant and agree as follows:

- 1) Scope of Services. Sports Commission shall use said \$3,744.00 as funding for field maintenance and umpire expenses for the Buck O'Neil Negro Leagues 2010

Baseball Classic baseball tournament, as more fully described in the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit A; and,

2) County's Obligation. The County agrees to pay the amount of \$3,744.00 to Sports Commission for the purpose of helping to fund the Buck O'Neil Negro Leagues 2010 Baseball Classic baseball tournament.

3) Terms of Payment. A lump sum payment of \$3,744.00 will be made in a timely manner upon execution of this Agreement.

4) Reports. Sports Commission shall submit a report, including cancelled checks and invoices, and any other documents requested by the Director of Finance and Purchasing, to establish that the funds provided pursuant to this Agreement were used for the purposes set forth herein. The report shall include an annual report which shall summarize all of Sports Commission's activities pursuant to this Agreement. Sports Commission's failure to submit this annual report shall disqualify Sports Commission from future funding by the County.

5) Submission of Documents. No payment shall be made under this contract until the contracting agency shall have submitted to the County's Director of Finance and Purchasing (1) a written proposal setting out in detail the intended use of the County's funding, including the target population to be served; (2) an audited financial statement for the agency's most recent fiscal year; (3) the agency's most recent IRS Form 990, if applicable, (4) a statement of the agency's total budget for its most recent fiscal year; and (5) a detailed explanation of actual expenditures of County funds pertaining to final payments and payments on contracts for future years.

6) Audit. The County further reserves the right to examine and audit, during

reasonable office hours, the books and records of Sports Commission pertaining to its finances and operations.

7) Default. If Sports Commission shall default in the performance or observation of any term or condition of this Agreement, the County shall give written notice setting forth the default and the correction required. If said default shall continue and not be corrected by Sports Commission within ten days of its receipt of said notice, the County may, at its election, terminate the Agreement and withhold any payments not yet made. Said election shall not in any way limit the County's right to seek legal redress.

8) Conflict of Interest. Sports Commission warrants that no officer or employee of the County, whether elected or appointed, shall in any manner whatsoever be interested in or receive any benefit from the profits or emoluments of this Agreement.

9) Severability. If any covenant or other provision of this Agreement is invalid or incapable of being enforced by reasons of any rule of law or public policy, all other conditions and provisions of this Agreement shall nevertheless remain in full force and effect and no covenant or provision shall be deemed dependent upon any other covenant or provision unless so expressed herein.

10) Term. This Agreement shall be effective January 1, 2010, and shall terminate on December 31, 2010. This Agreement may be terminated prior to that date by either party upon written notice, delivered thirty days prior to the effective date of termination. If this Agreement is terminated by either party, the County shall pay for only those services actually performed by Sports Commission as verified by the County's audit.

11) Incorporation. This Agreement incorporates the entire understanding and agreement of the parties.






