A RESOLUTION appointing James D. Tindall to the Kansas City Zoological District Commission.

RESOLUTION #17752, November 28, 2011

INTRODUCED BY Dennis Waits, County Legislator

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 4334, dated August 8, 2011, the Legislature did submit to the qualified voters of the County at a special election held on November 8, 2011, a question authorizing participation in the Kansas City Zoological District and approving a retail sales tax of one-eighth (1/8) of one cent for the support of zoological activities within the district; and,

WHEREAS, at that election, the voters of Jackson County, as well as those of Clay County, Missouri, approved the question submitted, and thus authorized the creation of the district and the imposition of the sales tax; and,

WHEREAS, section 184.506, RSMo Supp. 2010, the enabling legislation for the creation of the district, provides that the district be governed by a commission whose membership is to include a member of the governing body of each county which is a part of the district, who shall be appointed by majority vote of such governing body; and,

WHEREAS, it is now appropriate that the Legislature adopt this Resolution appointing one of its members to the commission, for a term to expire December 31, 2013; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following-named member of the Legislature be and hereby is appointed to the Kansas City Zoological District Commission for a term to expire December 31, 2013, under section 184.506, RSMo Supp. 2010:


