Credits are stand-alone transactions used to return funds to a card holder.

A credit does not reference a prior authorization processed on the gateway system.

By disabling the ability to process credits, a merchant is protected against unauthorized users being able to process credits, which would remove funds from the merchant's bank and issue funds to the unauthorized user's credit card number.
