## 5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Katheryn Shields, County Executive, said she participated with Mayor Cleaver in a press release today regarding the Million Can March. The Million Can March to fight hunger began January 15, 1997, and will end on June 19, 1997. Each city and county employee is asked to donate at least three cans of nonperishable food or donate \$1.00 within the next thirty days.

Katheryn Shields withdrew Executive Order #97-12 that was filed May 12, 1997. See page 4 for details.

Katheryn Shields gave an update on the privatization of the Jackson County Detention Center. She reported the county sent requests for qualifications to fifteen companies and received four responses. Only one company out of the four responses was qualified. She expects it will be mid-summer before a decision is reached on this issue.

Victor E. Callahan, Chairman, asked the County Executive to make copies of the responses received and distribute them to the Legislature for their review.

Fred Arbanas, County Legislator, asked for budget comparisons from other entities before and after privatization.

John Patrick Burnett, County Legislator, encouraged the administration to find out why the other two national companies did not respond. Fred Arbanas suggested sending registered letters to the two companies to ask if they are interested and allow them ten days to respond.

After much discussion, Katheryn Shields said she would provide the information requested by the Legislature.
