SUMMARY: A Resolution Authorizing the County Executive to execute the attached contract for the award of grant funding in the amount of \$200,000, for Mitigation in Confinement Facilities-COVID19, awarded by Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. The grant will be used to cover the purchase of eight (8) mobile heating cabinets that cost \$6,521.00 each; thirteen (13) heated tray carts that cost \$7,857.60 each; three (3) power washers that cost \$4,299 each; eight (8) auto floor scrubbers that cost \$3,999.00 each. The total expense for this equipment is \$199,201.00. This grant does not require Jackson County to match. An Appropriation is necessary to place the grant funds in the proper spending accounts.
