

I cannot in good conscience take the easy way out, and let this bad ordinance pass into law, when the safety of the public is at stake.

IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

AN ORDINANCE repealing section 5014., Jackson County Code, 1984, relating to certain activities prohibited in Jackson County parks, and enacting, in lieu thereof, one new section, relating to the same subject.

ORDINANCE #2020, August 12, 1991

INTRODUCED BY Fred Arbanas, Dennis Waits, and Robert Hertzog,
County Legislators

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County,
Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Enacting Clause. Sections 5014., Jackson County Code, 1984, is hereby repealed, and one new section enacted in lieu, thereof, to be known as section 5014., to read as follows:

5014. Hot Air Balloons.

Hot Air Balloons may be launched from launching sites designated by the Director of Parks and Recreation and are subject to permits and regulations promulgated by the Director. No person shall launch a Hot Air Balloon on any park land, lake, or waterway, except from a designated launching site or when authorized by the Director as a Special Event.

5014.1 Ultralight Aircraft.

No person shall operate any ultralight aircraft on any Jackson County park land, lake or waterway except when authorized by the Director of Special Events.

5014.2 Para-Sailing Equipment & Operation.

No person shall operate any para-sailing equipment or device on any Jackson County lake or waterway except when authorized by the Director.

5014.3 Bicycles/Mountain Bikes/All-Terrain Bikes.

No person shall operate any bicycle, mountain bike, all terrain bike, wide-tired bike or other non-motorized, pedal-operated vehicle in any Jackson County park except at the designated bike paths located at Longview Lake and Little Blue Trace, or on marked roads within any park.

[5014.4 Waterskiing/Jet Skiing Prohibited - Where.

No person shall waterski or operate a jet ski on Prairie Lee Lake except residents of lake front property at Prairie Lee Lake. Waterskiing by such residents shall be permitted only after sunrise and before sunset.]

Effective Date: This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its signature by the County Executive.
