13 UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Greg Grounds, County Legislator, asked for an accounting of funds used for the Martin Luther King Day celebration.

Dan Tarwater referred this request to the legislative auditor, Gary Panethiere and the Compliance Review Officer, Tom Wyrsch. He asked them to report back to the County Legislature with the information.

14 NEW BUSINESS

Henry C. Rizzo, County Legislator, asked legislators to review the oversight bulletin from Tom Wyrsch regarding the projects at Arrowhead stadiums. He said any questions or concerns should be directed to the Budget Committee members.

Dan Tarwater said they will have a construction time line available within the next two weeks.

Bob Spence, County Legislator, asked the bulletin contain more specific information. He asked Fred Siems, Chief Administrative Officer, what procedure the Administration has in place.

Fred Siems said they are finalizing the procedure to be followed.

Bob Spence asked what procedure is used when writing a check from the stadium account.

Henry C. Rizzo explained the teams contact the construction manager and the manager accepts or denies the request. The Chairman of the Sports Authority, along with the Chairman of the County Legislature and the County Executive then review it and two of them must sign off on the expenditure. It is then forwarded to Tom Wyrsch in the Compliance Review office and he will send it to the County Legislature.

Tom Wyrsch, Compliance Review Officer, said he receives requests for payment from Jim Rowland, Executive Director of the Jackson County Sports Authority.

Henry C. Rizzo said Tom Wyrsch has documents in his office for the County Legislature's review.

Bob Spence asked if Gary Panethiere was a part of this process.

Gary Panethiere, Legislative Auditor, said he was not but could be a part of the process.

Tom Wyrsch explained that up to this point his review has been after the fact but from now on it will be before the fact.

Dennis Waits, County Legislator, asked that the categories be broken down.

Bob Spence asked Mr. Wyrsch to be more detailed when reporting to the Legislature. He asked Gary Panethiere to oversee this review process with Tom Wyrsch.

Greg Grounds said this is good stewardship for the taxpayers. His concern is that we get the information in plenty of time, prior to voting on it, to satisfy his comfort level.

Henry C. Rizzo said the County Legislature has 14 days to turn down an expenditure.

Theresa Garza, County Legislator, asked if the legislators can be advised of design team meetings so they can attend or send a representative.

Dan Tarwater responded yes.

Greg Grounds asked that the reports be in digital format and sent by email.
