#### 5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Mike Sanders, County Executive, said July 22, 2013 is the extended deadline to file informal appeals with the Assessment Department. He said an additional step has been taken that allows the public to call the Assessment Department Monday through Thursday from 8 A.M. - 7 P.M. The extended hours for the phones will begin on Monday, June 24 and will continue until Monday, July 22. This information will be on Jackson County's website.

Robert Murphy, Chairman of the Board of Equalization (BOE), said they have extended the time frame to file formal appeals with BOE until July 29, 2013.

Curtis Koons, Director of Assessment, explained that because the information we have on condominiums is inconsistent, their values will be the same as they were in 2012.

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Bob Burnett said the review process is complete and notices will be in the mail by the end of this week. He said 68,000 notices will be remailed which includes 10,000 for condominiums.

Jason Ormiston with Todd Appraisals said he and assessment staff have looked at specific neighborhoods and areas they felt were out of line with current market conditions. They did a complete reconstruction of the assessment process. Field inspectors went out and reinspected all the properties. They developed new sales comparisons information, gathered additional sales data from the neighborhoods, as well as thorough data analysis a of all the recent sales activity since January 2012 and were able to pinpoint issues that caused initial values to be wrong. They are confident that the reexamination process has led to more fair and equitable values.

Nathaniel "Nate" Dorsey, Building Services Technician, received a proclamation on the occasion of his retirement effective June 14, 2013.
