## **USER AGREEMENT**

County of the State of Missou	uri, hereinafter referred to as "the County."			

WHEREAS, by Resolution #17305, dated June 14, 2010, the Jackson County Legislature did authorize the County to enter into a user agreement with the Kansas City, Missouri Board of Police Commissioners, in connection with the Kansas City Missouri Police Department ALERT II System, for use by the County's Sheriff's Office, Department of Corrections, and Prosecuting Attorney's Office; and,

WHEREAS, the ALERT II System is being phased out and replaced by the LEWeb law enforcement computer information service provided by REJIS, and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution 17597, dated May 23, 2011, the Jackson County Legislature did authorize the County to enter into a user agreement with REJIS, in connection with the conversion from the Alert II system previously provided by the Kansas City, Missouri Board of Police Commissioners, for use by the County's Prosecuting Attorney's and Sheriff's Offices, and the Department of Corrections; and,

NOW THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

1. REJIS shall grant certain privileges in connection with access to and use of its LEWeb (Law Enforcement) Web subscription services and training for the County, for

MARY JO SPINO COUNTY CLERK use by the County's Sheriff's Office, Prosecuting Attorney's Office, and Department of Corrections, as more fully described in the attached Scope of Services document, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A.

- 2. The County shall pay REJIS monthly for the provided services in accordance with the fee schedule, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit B. All charges for services shall be determined based upon the fee schedule. Fees for months thirteen through thirty-six, if authorized via written addendum, shall bill at an additional five percent monthly fee.
- June 30, 2012, unless sooner terminated. At the agreement of both parties, this Agreement may be extended beyond the initial term for up to two additional twelve-month extensions. REJIS shall provide a usage report to the County at the end of the initial term and at the end of any additional twelve-month extension periods. The subscription fee will be adjusted at the beginning of the year four to reflect the actual usage by the County.
- 4. REJIS may terminate this Agreement by giving thirty days written notice to the County. The County may terminate this Agreement by giving thirty days written notice to REJIS. Termination of this Agreement shall not constitute a waiver of the rights or obligations which the County or REJIS may be entitled to receive or be obligated to perform under this Agreement. Should this Agreement terminate, all papers, documents, books and all other County materials must be destroyed or delivered and returned by REJIS to the County within 30 days of the demand of the County.
- 5. If any covenant or other provision of this Agreement is invalid, or incapable of being enforced, by reason of any rule of law or public policy, all other conditions and

provisions of this Agreement shall nevertheless remain in full force and effect and no covenant or provision shall be deemed dependent upon any other covenant or provision unless so expressed herein.

- 6. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Missouri.
- 7. This Agreement, together with the attached Exhibit A, incorporates the entire understanding and agreement of the parties.


