IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

AN ORDINANCE amending the zoning districts established pursuant to the Unified Development Code by changing from District A (Agricultural) to District RE (Residential Estates) a certain 2.3 ± acre lot.

ORDINANCE #4198, March 29, 2010

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Zoning Order of Jackson County, Missouri, and the official maps which are a part thereof, are amended by changing the boundaries of the "A" (Agricultural) District and the "RE" (Residential Estates) District, so that there will be transferred from District A to District RE, a tract of land described as follows:

Description: The 2.3 \pm acre lot is located approximately one-quarter of a mile north of Milton Thompson Road on the west side of Howard Road and is legally described as Lot 1, Highland View, a subdivision lying in the southwest quarter of Section 36, Township 48, Range 31 in Jackson County, Missouri aka 10310 Howard Road.

<u>Section 2</u>. The Legislature, pursuant to the application of David Whalen (RZ-2010-470), requesting the amendment embodied in this Ordinance and with notice that the Jackson County Plan Commission unanimously recommended approval of this application in a public hearing on March 18, 2010, does adopt this Ordinance pursuant to the Jackson County Charter authorizing the Legislature to exercise legislative power pertaining to planning and zoning.
