This Addendum is made by and between Jackson County, Mo., hereinafter called "the County," and Patterson Latimer Jones Brannon Denham Inc., hereinafter called "Architect," this 9 day of Nivember 2010.

Whereas, it is the mutual desire of the parties hereto to amend the AGREEMENT for PROFESSIONAL ARCHITECTUAL SERVICES for the Independence/Jackson County Animal Control Building entered into on July 21, 2009, hereinafter called "the Existing Agreement," and Addendum No. 1 to the Existing Agreement, entered into on April 29, 2010.

Therefore, it is hereby agreed that the Existing Agreement be amended as follows:

ARTICLE II – ADDITIONAL SERVICES:

The following items as described herein and summarized on attached Exhibits A & B are for additional services to be provided by the Architect:

The Period of Service shall be until completed after the date of approval of this Addendum No. 2. All other services and deliverables shall remain as stated in the Existing Agreement and Addendum No. 1.

ARTICLE XIII – PAYMENTS TO ARCHITECT:

The payment provision shall be revised as described below:

COUNTY will pay a fee not to exceed \$134,080.00, as compensation for Required Additional Services, including expenses, as set forth in the attached Architect's Exhibit A, except that the lump sum of \$7,485.00 may be billed for Engineering Services subcontracted to Olson & Associates, as is more fully set out in Exhibit B. All payments to ARCHITECT for these Additional Services shall be made in conformance to the payment terms in the original Agreement.

ARTICLE IV – ATTACHMENTS:

Exhibit **A & B** - Summary of Architectural scope and fees for additional work.

This Addendum will be deemed a part of, and be subject to, all terms and conditions of the Existing Agreement. Except as modified above, the Existing Agreement will remain in full force and effect.

EXHIBIT "A"

Scope of Design Services:

A. Design Development (Redesign):

- 1. Working in conjunction with Jackson County Animal Shelter Consultant Courtney Thomas and develop a redesigned floor plan of reduced square footage.
- 2. The following building components and systems will be redesigned and defined to accomplish budget control.

Division 3- Concrete

- Revised floor plan allows for single slope floors to trench drains and deletes the need for a variety of foundation walls and footings.
- Simplified construction.

Division 4 - Masonry

• Masonry reduction as result of one kennel wing design in lieu of three separate wings.

Division 5- Metals

- Structural steel reduction as a result of redesign.
- Delete all metal stud walls

Division 6 - Wood and Plastics

• Reduced number of wood trusses, LVL beams and plywood. Delete all upper level equipment platforms and log accents at window awnings.

Division-7- Thermal and Moisture Protection

- Utilize standard Heritage 30 year warranty shingles.
- Use standard cedar siding in lieu of wavy beveled edge siding.
- Delete half round gutters with round downspouts and use standard "K" style gutter and downspouts.

Division 8 – Doors and Windows

- Extensive reduction in the number of walk and overhead doors as per Floor Plan revision.
- Delete all electric security latches.
- Delete all operable window vent sections.

Division 9 – Finishes

- Delete all metal stud wall gyp. board and gyp. board overlays to cover masonry block at exterior walls.
- Delete all vinyl wall covering except at the main Lobby / Reception.
- All interior wall finishes to be painted block, except for main Lobby.
- All floors to be sealed concrete with some color tint areas.

Division 10 – Specialties

Division 11 – Equipment

- Delete equipment platform retractable stairs.
- Delete all shelter accessories except surgery and exam lights (connection of all other equipment included)

Division 13 – Special Construction

• Utilize glass front kennels with swing gates.

Division 21 - Fire Suppression

- Three kennel wings with dry pipe system in the truss areas deleted.
- Utilize antifreeze system in lieu of dry pipe where required.

Division 22 – Plumbing

- Delete the cistern system, spraymaster system, and in floor radiant heat.
- Utilize trench drains in lieu of individual floor drains in kennel areas.

Division 23 – Mechanical

- Use all roof mounted HVAC equipment and exhaust with simplified ductwork due to kennel area redesign.
- Delete remote system monitoring.

Division 26 – Electrical

- Delete security system, low voltage conduit and cabling.
- Use aluminum service conductors.
- Delete exterior bollard lighting and gasket sealed doors at kennel light fixtures.
- Utilize MC cable for power and switching where applicable by code.

Division 31 - Earthwork

Separate contract awarded by Jackson County.

Division 32 – Exterior Improvements

- Delete two each contoured and landscaped courtyards and enclose courtyard East
 of the kennel wing with PVC coated chain link fence and limited landscaping.
 - 3. Develop Site Plan Review Documents for approval by the City of Independence. Including any related code approvals.

B. Construction Document and Bidding

1. Develop Construction Documents: Based on the approved redesign drawings and specifications and any further adjustments in the scope of quality of the project or in the project budget authorized by the designated group, construction documents will be prepared consisting of drawings and specifications, setting forth in detail the exact requirements for the construction of the project. The construction documents shall include the standard general conditions, contract documents, and forms as required to meet the project design. These documents shall also include all architectural, structural, mechanical, plumbing, electrical, site work, landscaping, utilities, and equipment as required, to provide a complete functional and operational building.

- 2. Items and materials specifically to be included in the Contract Documents are the following:
 - a. Surgery / exam lights
 - b. Suspended acoustical ceiling for noise Reduction control
 - c. Floor drains at areas of wash down where trench drains are not
 - d. Flushing trench drain systems in open space kennel systems
 - e. Air handling system allowing for odor control and humidity control.
 - f. Building sound/intercom system
 - g. Rough-in for owner supplied educational projectors / televisions as directed
- 3. Probable Construction Costs: A final statement of Probable Construction Costs will be generated.
- 4. Bidding: Following the designated group's approval of the construction documents and the final Statement of Probable Construction Cost, Patterson Latimer Jones Brannon Denham, Inc., will assist in obtaining bids from contractors, in awarding the contract, and preparing for construction.
- 5. If bids received are outside the established budget of \$5,000,000.00 PLJBD and their Consultants will work directly with the Bidder with the lowest Base Bid to value engineer the project to be within budget. Documents shall be prepared utilizing features and systems which fall within the budget based on the generated probable cost. Design documents for features and systems as deductive or add alternates will not be generated as part of the Addendum No. 2 fee structure.

C. Construction Administration and Observation:

- 1. The Construction Phase will commence with the award of the Contract for Construction and will terminate when final payment of the contractor is due and construction is completed.
- 2. Construction Administration Phase Architectural-Engineering contract includes the following:
 - a. Owner representative for clarifications and supplemental instructions and design as needed.
 - b. Shop drawing review and approval
 - c. Change order generation as required
 - d. Provide input, plans and schedules working with Owner's consultant to develop the project interior and exterior color schedule.
 - e. Bi-Weekly progress meeting attendance and input
 - f. Request for payment review and approval
 - g. Punch list generation and review for compliance
 - h. As built-drawing generation
 - i. Closeout document collection and delivery to owner
