WHEREAS, the recommended extension will allow these agencies to utilize the allocation provided to them in 2011, but which they have encountered delays in spending; now

therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute extensions to the agreements with the outside agencies listed above, until April 30, 2012, in a form to be approved by the County Counselor; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the agreements.
