## **ORDINANCES IN COMMITTEE**

Bob Spence moved to recommend for perfection Ordinance #3772, amending the zoning districts established pursuant to the Unified Development Code by changing from District A (Agricultural) to District RR

(Residential Ranchette) a certain 5.5± acre tract. Seconded by Rhonda L. Shoemaker.

The motion passed by a voice vote. (APPROVED)

Bob Spence moved to recommend for perfection Ordinance #3773, amending the zoning districts established pursuant to the Unified Development Code by changing from A (Agricultural) to RR-p (Residential Ranchette - Planned Development) a certain 64.6 ± acre tract and approving the preliminary plat "Llewellyn Acres, 2nd Plat," creating an eleven-lot residential subdivision. Seconded by Rhonda L. Shoemaker.
