5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Mike Sanders, County Executive, presented a check to Sister Berta with Operation Breakthrough, in the amount of \$16,500.00. Operation Breakthrough is a local non-profit organization that was founded in 1971. They serve over 600 children daily through daycare services as well as providing them with food, health care, and educational opportunities. The majority of families enrolled in Operation Breakthrough live at or below the federal poverty level. The money was raised through the annual Jackson County Executive Golf Tournament, which took place on September 9 at Fred Arbanas Golf Course. A total of \$34,500 has been raised for Operation Breakthrough the last two years of the golf tournament.

Mike Sanders presented a proclamation and a plaque to James Earl McCoy, Manager of Detention with the Corrections Department. Mr. McCoy will retire on December 16, 2011 after 39 years of service with Jackson County, Missouri.
