Request Summary

Various County Departments require a Term and Supply Contract for the furnishing of Car Wash & Detail Services. The Purchasing Department issued Invitation to Bid No. 23-001 in response to those requirements. A total of None (9) notifications were distributed, thirteen (13) document takers with Four (4) responses from the following received and evaluated.

- Cable Dahmer Automotive
- Pro Detailing Solution
- · Rynse Inc
- Tidal Wave Auto Spa

During the evaluation process, Pro Detailing Solution was eliminated for a lack of response. An Executive Summary of the Invitation to Bid, including the Contractor's Quotations and the using departments Recommendation Memos are attached.

Pursuant to Section 1054.6 of the Jackson County Code, the Purchasing Department recommends a split award of a Twelve (12) Month Term and Supply Contract with One (1) Twelve Month Option to Extend for the furnishing of Car Wash & Detailing Services to Cable Dahmer Automotive of Lee's Summit, Missouri; Rynse Inc of Santa Monica, California and Tidal Wave Auto Spa of Thomaston, Georgia under the terms and conditions of Invitation to Bid No. 23-001 as the best qualified bids received. A split award is recommended for this bid which will give County Departments various options across the Greater Kansas City Metro Area to utilize this service.

Various County Departments have stated an annual estimated usage of \$48,000. The award is made on an "as needed" basis and does not obligate Jackson County to pay any specific amount. The availability of funds for specific purchases is subject to annual appropriations.

SUBJECT: Term & Supply Contract No. 23-01, Car Wash Services

The Parks + Rec Department's recommendation is to award the Car Wash Services contract to two vendors. Split award to Cable Dahmer and Rynse.

Cable Dahmer was low bid for basic wash; however, they only offer three locations in the metro area, and they did not quote detail services. Also, they do not have self-service wash bays that are critical for some Parks work trucks that are unable to use traditional drive through wash facilities.

Rynse has dozens of locations for drive through service in the metro area and they offer self-service wash bays. The numerous options for service will help Parks utilize one closest to the park site that needs this service. We have staff and vehicles assigned to sites that are located throughout the entire County, including Sibley, Kansas City, Independence, Grandview, Blue Springs, and Lee's Summit.

Parks + Rec projected usage during the next twelve months is \$5,000, subject budget approval/availability.

A Contract between Jackson County Missouri ("County") and the undersigned ("Contractor"), collectively referred to as the "parties". The term "offer" as used herein refers to Contractor's offer made in response to this Bid Number. The parties agree as follows in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein.

This Contract shall be binding when it is signed by the County's Purchasing Officer and shall run from such date until the end of the 12th consecutive month from the month during which it first took effect unless it is sooner terminated in accord herewith.

This Contract consists of: (1) Contractor's offer, including those papers which Contractor submitted with or expressly incorporated in its offer as a part thereof, to the extent the terms of such papers were expressly or impliedly accepted by the County, or were modified in writing with the express or implied consent of the parties; (2) written modification to this Contract signed by the County's Purchasing Officer and consented to expressly or impliedly by Contractor.
