WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney's Family Support Division recommends an agreement with the National Center for Fathering to provide continuing fathering training sessions for clients of the Division's Fathering Court Project, at a cost not to exceed \$25,000.00, for the period March 1, 2012, to December 31, 2012; and,


WHEREAS, this agreement is in the best interests of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of Jackson County; now therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute an Agreement with the National Center for Fathering, in a form to be approved by the County Counselor; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the Agreement.



The National Center for Fathering will provide the Jackson County Family Support Division the following services at the Pioneer Campus:</p> <p>2012 Fathering classes (3 sessions) Women's & Men's Intensive Training class (1 session)</p> <p>Program Expenses: All out-of-pocket costs for program materials, instructors, meeting costs, facility rentals, assessments, office supplies, transportation and recognition items are included.</p> <p>The National Center for Fathering was selected to provide fathering training to the participants of Fathering/Child Support Court for a number of reasons: First, they are respected nationally and internationally as the leading father training organization, reaching more than 5,000 dads in face-to-face training each year. Second, they are the sole source of research-based fathering training in the Kansas City area. Third, they are the authors and developers of the Quenching the Father Thirst curriculum that has been integral to the success of Fathering/Child Support Court to date. Fourth, their staff have been key contributors to Fathering/Child Support Court and the instructors of the required fathering class since its inception in 1998.</p> <p>The effective period of this agreement is 1 March 2012 thru 31 December 2012.</p>
