Victor E. Callahan, Chairman, said that the Legislature is not being informed about litigation and legal matters regarding the County. He suggested that the County Counselor inform the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, or any other member of the Legislature of any developments concerning these lawsuits.

Sandy Schermerhorn, County Counselor, said that she would be willing to meet once a week with Victor Callahan to discuss matters.

Fred Arbanas, County Legislator, asked for a TIF update.

Jay Haden, Deputy County Counselor, responded that the judge issued partial summary judgement on the TIF case relating to whether the sales taxes for the I-470 TIF project were captured under the TIF law. The order says that the TIF sales taxes were subject to being captured but that we did not have to include them for purposes of calculating our rollback. He said that the county will not appeal.

Fred Arbanas asked for a dollar amount.

Jay Haden said he did not have an actual figure.

Victor Callahan questions who made the decision not to appeal. He asked for an Executive Session next week to bring the Legislature up to date on litigation.
