INTRODUCED BY Bob Spence, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the County and the City of Oak Grove desire to enter into a Cooperative Agreement for the purposes of providing road maintenance and snow removal services; and,

WHEREAS, sections 70.210 to 70.325 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri authorize political subdivisions to enter into Cooperative Agreements for road maintenance and snow removal in order to increase efficiency and reduce costs; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and the roads involved in the Agreement are listed therein; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works and the City of Oak Grove both recommend this Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, this Agreement is in the best interest of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the County; now therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute the attached Cooperative Agreement with the City of Oak Grove, Missouri, for road maintenance and snow removal services.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
