5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Katheryn Shields, County Executive, introduced Michael G. O'Flaherty, her appointment to the Land Trust of Jackson County, Missouri.

Jackson County is working jointly with the City of Kansas City to clean up a stretch of Lee's Summit Road near TMC-East that has become unsafe. The county owns property just south of the curve and has cleared trees and brush. The city owns the road and right of way and has added a rock shoulder as well as warning signs. Katheryn thanked the Public Works Departments from both the county and the city for all of their hard work. She will try to schedule a press conference this Friday to bring attention to this improvement.

Katheryn Shields announced that tomorrow is the Green Purchasing Vendor Fair and Workshop at Bartle Hall. Jackson County is a sponsor and she is encouraging everyone to attend. Tomorrow is also the 1st-ever Metrowide "Clean Out Your Files Day". This is the third year that Jackson County has participated in a "Clean Out Your Files Day" and the county will be providing a drop off site for downtown businesses.
