ARTICLE I

PURPOSE AND AUTHORITY

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets forth the points of agreement between the Social Security Administration (SSA), the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and Vance Brothers, Inc. (Employer) regarding the Employer's participation in the Employment Eligibility Verification Program (E-Verify).
