



In August 2024, RC Goodwin and Associates was hired to conduct a Cultural Resource Survey for the cost of \$9,503. An engineering firm will be hired to design the project for the cost of \$27,500. The entire project will be designed before a federal award is received. The total of Pre-Award Cost is \$37,003.
