ATTACHMENT 3
DOMESTIC PRODUCTS PROCUREMENT ACT (BUY AMERICAN) PREFERENCE

In accordance with sections 34.350-34.359, RSMo, the vendor is instructed to provide information regarding the point of manufacture for each of the products being proposed so that the product's eligibility for the Domestic Products Procurement Act (Buy American) Preference can be determined. 
