## 5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Katheryn Shields, County Executive, informed the Legislature that the History Channel will send a film crew to the Jackson County Courthouse on the Independence Square on Wednesday, September 16, 1998. They will be using interior and exterior shots of the building as they are doing a program on the history of the FBI with a focus on the Union Station Massacre and the Richetti trial. They will be using Judge Scoville's courtroom to reenact the courtroom scenes.

Katheryn Shields said that Resolution #12344 has been introduced which is a change order on the jail for approximately a half million dollars. It is for new items dealing with the electronics going to a central control system which the transition team and the detention center staff agree will make the building work more efficiently and more cost effectively. Staff will be present next week to answer any questions in detail.
