REQUEST SUMMARY	We are requesting that the County Executive be authorized to execute the attached Permanent and Temporary Construction Easements to allow Kansas City Water Services Department to install a replacement section to an existing 30" water main located north of Bannister Road in the Blue River Parkway. The new line is to replace an existing section that is prone to breaking. The new line through the park will be directionally drilled underground and therefore will cause minimal disturbance above ground. The line is located in an area not readily accessible to the public and will not have a negative impact to park usage. Park staff therefore has no objection to granting the easements. Kansas City Water Services has agreed to pay the \$0.20/square foot easement fee, (\$980.20) and the \$2,000.00 easement processing fee. We further request the fees from this action be accepted and appropriated into account 003-1608 8060.

This is a request for permanent and temporary easements for the relocation of an existing 30-inch water main north of Bannister Road and east of the Federal Complex at 1500 Bannister Road. See attached Figure 1. A segment of the existing water main is in a 20-foot wide permanent easement (K508522 at Book K1116, Page 1101), obtained from Jackson County, Missouri in 1981. This easement extends from the centerline of Blue River to the MoDOT right of way for Bannister Road (Missouri Route W) and continues on the south side of Bannister Road. Erosion and shifting of the Blue River has exposed a portion of the existing 30-inch water main on the north bank.

Water Services proposes to install approximately 636 feet of new 30-inch transmission main parallel to the existing main to provide a new Blue River crossing and replace a break-prone section of pipe. Installation of a main parallel to the existing main is necessary to maintain service until final connections are constructed and the existing main segment abandoned. Approximately 470 feet of the proposed new water main, including the Blue River crossing, will be installed using horizontal directional drilling techniques and pulling in new 30-inch fusible polyvinyl chloride (PVC) piping. The segment of new water main within the Jackson County limits will be installed by horizontal directional drilling.

The existing permanent easement from Jackson County must be augmented for the new 30-inch water main segment, and a temporary construction easement is also required. The Jackson County property within the proposed new easements is currently undeveloped park land with no structures.

Please find enclosed the requested permanent and temporary easement documents with exhibits for your review.



Sub: Permanent and Temporary Construction Easements to K. C. Water Services Department in the Blue River Parkway

K. C. Water Services is requesting passage of an Ordinance approving a Permanent and Temporary Construction Easement to install a 470' replacement section of 30" water main in the Blue River Parkway north of Bannister Road.

Background:

- K. C. Water Services needs to replace a 470 foot section of water main under Blue River Parkway that is prone to breaking.
- The line will be directionally drilled underground and will have minimal impact to the surface.
- They are requesting a permanent easement of 4,901 sq. feet.
- The easement will not have a negative impact on the Blue River Parkway.
- K. C. Water Services has agreed to pay the \$0.20/square foot easement fee, (\$980.20) and the \$2,000.00 easement processing fee.
- Easement fees will be appropriated to account 003-1608-8060; Park Fund Construction Services and other improvements.
