

EIGHTEENTH ADDENDUM
LEGAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS EIGHTEENTH ADDENDUM TO AGREEMENT, made and entered into on this 6th day of October, 2025, by and between **JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI**, hereinafter called "the County" and **HUSCH BLACKWELL LLP**, 4801 Main Street, Suite 1000, Kansas City, MO 64112, hereinafter called "Legal Counsel."

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, Legal Counsel has entered into a Legal Services Agreement dated October 6, 2025 whereunder Legal Counsel agreed to provide legal advice to the County in connection with general employment or municipal law, consultation, representation, and training; and,

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to increase the maximum sum available for services rendered under this Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the terms and provisions herein contained, County and Legal Counsel respectively promise, covenant, and agree with each other as follows:

1. Except as expressly provided herein, all provisions of the prior Legal Services Agreement dated March 27, 2013, and all previous addendums, shall remain in full force and effect pursuant to their terms.
2. The maximum sum to be paid by County to Legal Counsel shall be \$65,000. Any amount of legal services that would exceed this amount must be approved in advance and in writing by the County Counselor.

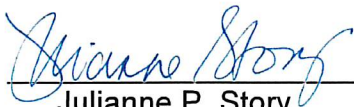

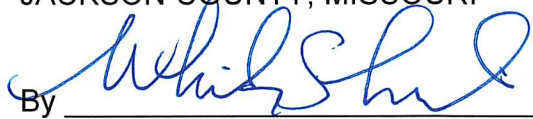
3. Article 5 of the Jackson County Charter places the full authority for directing the civil law business of the County on the County Counselor. As such, any work assigned by County to Legal Counsel must come at the request of the County Counselor.
4. This Eighteenth Addendum shall be effective as of October 1, 2025, and shall remain in effect, together with the Agreement of March 27, 2013, and all previous addendums, until March 31, 2026.
5. This Eighteenth Addendum to Agreement, together with the Legal Services Agreement dated March 27, 2013, and all previous addendums, incorporates the entire understanding and agreement of the parties.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have signed and executed this Agreement on the date first above written.

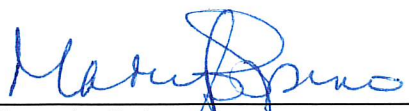
